CONSENT TO ATTORNEY FEES
(Local Rule 71.2)

Attorney fees for the administration of a decedent's estate are to be reasonable and beneficial to the decedent's estate. The Court has the ultimate responsibility and authority to determine attorney fees in a decedent's estate.

Local Rule 71.2 sets forth a schedule of fees that the Court presumes to be reasonable. Attorneys seeking payment of fees file a computation worksheet with the Court showing the fee calculation. In this case, the computation worksheet totals \$_____.

In addition to attorney fees for ordinary services, the attorney for the fiduciary may be allowed further reasonable attorney fees for any extraordinary service. What is an extraordinary service may vary depending upon many factors including the complexity and difficulty of the estate and the various matters and questions involved. In this case, a motion for extraordinary fees was filed seeking additional fees in the amount of \$_____ for a total fee of \$_____.

The undersigned fiduciary and/or residual beneficiaries of the estate consent to the payment of attorney fees to _____ in the amount of \$_____ plus reimbursement for costs advanced in the amount of \$_____.

Furthermore, we understand that we are under no obligation to consent to the payment of extraordinary attorney fees. We acknowledge that by signing this consent, we are waiving our right to have a hearing on the issue of attorney fees and the Court may approve the proposed attorney fee without further hearing.
