In re: Adoption of Local Rules

Judgment Entry

The Court deems an immediate need exists for revision of Local Rule 9(N) to allow for judicial economy and efficiency. The new rule reads as follows:

Local Rule 9(N)

Requests for compensation shall be made by each appointed attorney on forms supplied by the Ohio Public Defender Commission. The requests for compensation and reimbursement shall meet the guidelines established by the Ohio Public Defender Commission and be filed within 30 days of the date of the journal entry disposing of the complaint/motion or as otherwise contemplated by the Ohio Public Defender's Standards and Guidelines which would allow for reimbursement by the county. An attorney may be denied reimbursement for failure to meet this deadline or to comply with other reimbursement requirements.

This rule will take effect immediately. The Court will accept public comment on the rule change until Jan. 31, 2025, and thereafter consider whether to adopt said rule moving forward.
