### INITIATION REQUIREMENTS

- Filing Fee and Deposit of \$662.00
- Must have attorney
- Form 18.0 – Petition for Adoption of Minor (*RC 3107.05*)
- Minor must be living in home of petitioner for at least 6 months
- Petitioner is resident of Wayne County
- Form 18.0.1 WC Probate Form Adoption Application, Marriage-Divorce Information
  - Copy of Marriage License for petitioner(s) if married outside of Wayne County
- Form 18.0.2 Custody Affidavit – Adoption
- Form 18.0.3 WC Probate Form – Affidavit Regarding Birth Father
- Form 18.3.1 (if applicable) WC Probate Form – Affidavit of Unknown Name/Residence of Father
- Form 18.3 – Consent to Adoption (*RC 3107.06, 3107.081*) (*ALSO SEE BELOW FOR HEARING REQUIREMENTS*)
  - Mother  Father
  - Putative Father  Child (in open court)
- Form 18.2 – Notice of Hearing on Petition for Adoption, if applicable (*RC 3107.11*)
- 18.9 Petitioner's Preliminary Account (*RC 3107.055*)
- Certified copy of minor's birth certificate (*RC 3107.05*).

- Form JFS 1697 – Ohio Putative Registry Certification unless any exception of R.C. 3107.064(B) is applicable; if any exception of R.C. 3107.064(B) is applicable, then evidence of that exception shall be filed in lieu of Form JFS 1697 (R.C. 3107.062, 3107.063, 3107.064).
- File proposed forms for judge's signature as necessary

### **HEARING REQUIREMENTS – FOR PETITIONER/ATTORNEY**

- \_\_\_ Form 18.9 - Petitioner’s Account – Final Accounting (*to be filed not later than 10 days prior to date of final hearing*) (RC 3107.055)
  
- \_\_\_ Form JFS 1679 - Request for Notification (if JFS 1616 Social/Medical History filed) (RC 3107.09, .091, 3107.17)

### **CONSENT REQUIREMENTS**

- \_\_\_ Form 18.3 – CONSENT – TO BE EXECUTED IN PRESENCE OF COURT:
  - \_\_\_A. MINOR more than twelve years of age (RC 3107.06)
  - \_\_\_B: PARENT of a minor, who will be, if adopted, an adopted person as defined in section 3107.45 of the Revised Code, shall do all of the following as a condition of a court accepting the parent’s consent to the minor’s adoption (RC 3107.081(A) )
    - \_\_\_(1) Appear personally before the court:
    - \_\_\_(2) Sign the component of the form prescribed under division (A)(1)(a) of section 3107.083 of the Revised Code (Form JFS 01693 – Ohio Law and Adoption Materials)
  - \_\_\_C: PARENT of a minor, who is less than six months of age and will be, if adopted, an adopted person as defined in section 3107.45 of the Revised Code, may consent to the minor’s adoption without personally appearing before a court if both parents do all of the following: (RC 3107.081(B))
    - \_\_\_(1) Execute a notarized statement of consent to the minor’s adoption before the attorney arranging the adoption
    - \_\_\_(2) Sign the component of the form prescribed under division (A)(1)(a) of section 3107.83 of the Revised Code (Form JFS 01693 – Ohio Law and Adoption Materials)
  - \_\_\_D: PARENT of a minor to be adopted that resides in another state, may consent to the minor’s adoption without appearing personally before a court if the parent executes consent in the presence of a person authorized to take acknowledgments. The attorney arranging the adoption shall file the consent with the court and give the parent a copy of the consent. The court and attorney shall keep a copy of the consent in the court and attorney’s records of the adoption. (RC 3107.081(F))
